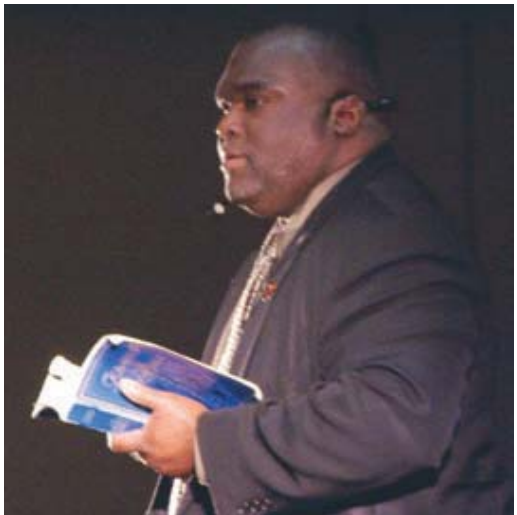
We will visit the Shrine of The Divine Mercy and see the convent of St. Faustina, where she lived and died, in Krakow, Poland. We will visit the tomb of St. Faustina, the home of Pope John Paul II, the famous Icon of Our Lady of Czestochowa, and the concentration camp of Auschwitz, where St. Maximilian Kolbe died. We will visit the shrine of the Infant Jesus of Prague go to Vienna, Austria and Budapest, Hungary. We will travel to Medjugorje where we will spend a few days. We will then travel to Athens, Corinth and Philippi, Greece. We will spend a day at the beach on the Olympic Riviera and take an overnight cruise to Italy. There will be a healing mass, confession, and retreat discussions with the Monsignor each day. This schedule is subject to change based on the number of pilgrims and the airline.
